Executive Summary:

The following is the final report on the City of Inkom's Land Use Community Survey which was completed in December 2013. The individual questions contained in the survey are listed along with a graphical representation of the results where appropriate. Written responses to questions are also provided following the specific question asked. **Please note** that the written responses are provided exactly as written with no editing.

Highlights of Survey Results:

- There is significant public support for a new restaurant if one was brought to the City
- There is a strong desire by the Community to have an Immediate Medical Care locate in the City
- There is a strong desire for a Library
- There is interest in Senior Housing
- The City is very supportive of the Local Government

2. What are the problems and challenges facing the City of Inkom?

Growth, Cleanliness

Landlocked, not enough real estate for growth - Need more business for the base.
