## New Resident Information

UTILITY BILLS—will be mailed by the 1st business day of each month, and are due immediately thereafter. Accounts are considered delinquent if not paid by the 10th of each month.

The fees are as follows:

**Water**— See Resolution #336 below

**Sewer**— \$46.35

**Garbage**— \$ 13.39

Payments can be made at City Hall; Monday-Friday from 9AM to 5PM (closed 1PM to 2PM for lunch), or left in the black drop box in front of City Hall, or mailed to our office address (above).

GARBAGE—Garbage is picked up each Thursday. Please have your garbage can on the street no later than 7 a.m. Thursday morning. Then remove can from the street the same day. Check to see what side of the street cans should be on for pickup. If a holiday falls on a Thursday, the garbage will be picked up the next day (Friday).

DOGS—Dogs older than three month need a License & Tags. The fee is \$5.00 for January only, and February thru December

31, is \$10.00. Dog licenses must be renewed every year.

PAVILLION RESERVATIONS—Any time after January 1st each year, the Skyline Park Pavilion can be rented for your use. It is an all day rental from 9:00 A.M. to 11:00 P.M. For City residents it is \$15.90 plus a \$20.00 refundable cleaning deposit if left clean and no damage. Reservations are made at City Hall or through our website.

WINTER PARKING—The annual winter challenge of the Street Department is to keep the streets clear and safe. No parking is allowed on Either side of the entire length of Rapid Creek Road, Grant Street, Main Street and Holstein Street, between the hours of 5:30 A.M. to 7:30 A.M., of any day during the period from Nov. 1st to April 30th. Citations will be issued for vehicles, trailers, etc. left on city streets from November 1st to April 30th.

### RESOLUTION #336:

**Whereas**, the City of Inkom provides a revenue for the ownership, operation and maintenance for the city water system by charging a monthly user fee to each system user, and;

**Whereas**, these changes are reviewed annually and user rates set by Resolution as set forth in Water Ordinance No. 99-1995 Section 13.04.050, and;

**Whereas**, the City Council having recognized an increase is now justified and in fact required to set the following monthly water rates beginning October 1, 2017.

- Base water rate for 3/4 inch meter: \$23.33 for the first 6,000 gallons , then \$1.06 per 1,000 gallons thereafter.
- Base water rate for 1 inch meter: \$33.94 for the first 6,000 gallons , then \$1.06 per 1,000 gallons thereafter.

- Base water rate for 1.5-inch meter: \$67.89 for the first 5,000 gallons , then \$1.06 per 1,000 gallons thereafter.
- Base water rate for 2-inch meter: \$116.59 for the first 5,000 gallons , then \$1.06 per 1,000 gallons thereafter.
- Base water rate for 3-inch meter: \$256.73 for the first 5,000 gallons , then \$1.06 per 1,000 gallons thereafter.
- Base water rate for 4-inch meter: \$453.00 for the first 5,000 gallons , then \$1.06 per 1,000 gallons thereafter.

**Whereas**, the effective date of this Resolution shall be October 1, 2017. It is hereby passed by the City Council and approved by the Mayor at a City Council meeting held on this date: September 14, 2017
